FACILITY RULES



- 1. The Oregon Park District will not tolerate any inappropriate language, improper clothing or suggestive comments.
- 2. All users of Nash Recreation Center are expected to be responsible, courteous and safety-conscious at all times.
- 3. All patrons are to sign in or swipe in when entering the Nash Rec Center.
- 4. The Oregon Park District is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items. Please keep all personal items in locked lockers or with your person(s).
- 5. Children 3rd Grade and under are not allowed to use the facility alone unless attending a specific, regularly scheduled Oregon Park District program or unless otherwise stated, and must be accompanied by a person junior high age or older.
- 6. You must be in 7th grade or older to use the Fitness Center. 7th & 8th graders will be required to have their report card as proof of age when they receive an orientation. You must be in 9th grade or older in order to use the free weights.
- 7. Proper attire (sweat suits, warm ups, shorts) is required. All users must wear shirts and shoes within the Nash Recreation Center. Bathing suits must be covered when not in the locker rooms or aquatic areas.
- 8. Smoking, gambling, chewing tobacco, spitting, use of alcoholic beverages or narcotic drugs is NOT permitted in Nash Recreation Center.
- 9. Food and beverage is only allowed in the Snack Bar unless otherwise stated.
- 10. Personal audio equipment may only be used with headphones.
- 11. The Park District has a lost and found department. Items are retained in the lost and found for one month, at which time they are disposed of.
- 12. Failure to follow rules will result in removal from the Nash Recreation Center and individuals will be subject to the Behavior Management Policy.
