



Election Information

Nominating petition forms for the April 6, 2021 park board election for the Oregon Park District will be available beginning September 22, 2020. The petition form packet may be picked up at the Nash Recreation Center during normal operating hours.

To be eligible to serve, a park board member must be, on the date of election, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old, a registered voter, and a resident of the State of Illinois and the park district for at least one year immediately preceding the election. Elections are non-partisan and board candidates do not indicate a political party affiliation. Candidates should be aware of financial conflict-of-interest limitations set forth in state law.
